



Poll: Obama would beat McCain, but Clinton would lose in Wis.

MADISON, Wis. (AP) - A new poll indicates that Wisconsin voters have no clear favorite in the presidential race.

The poll shows that Democrat Barack Obama would beat Republican John McCain 46% to 42% but Hillary Rodham Clinton would lose to McCain by the same margin.

Both victories are within the poll's 5%age point margin of error.

Obama and Clinton remain locked in a tight contest for the party's nomination.

The random telephone poll of 400 Wisconsin residents was conducted between March 25 and April 5.
